- Keller: Same day travel, registration Saturday morning at Timber Creek High School, 12350 Timberland Blvd, Keller, TX 76244
- Kilgore: May stay Friday night or do same day travel, registration Saturday morning at Kilgore College, 1100 Broadway, Kilgore, TX 75662. For those wanting to stay Friday night, Comfort Inn offers \$89.99 plus tax per room (\$101.69). They are located at 1212 Hiway 259 N, Kilgore, TX 75662. Call 903-984-2385 to make a reservation.
- Denton: May stay Friday and/or Saturday night or do same day travel. We have a block of rooms reserved for the evenings of March 23rd and March 24th at the Holiday Inn Express. If you want a room for either or both nights, call 940-808-0600 and reserve with Sachse Swingsters group code: SBC. The room rates are \$115 per night plus tax. The rooms will be available at this rate until March 9, 2012. You can cancel your reservation if you call before 4pm the day before your reservation starts.
